NOMINATIONS

Nominating ballots for the **Office of District President** and for the **1**st **Vice President** are to be in the hands of the District's congregations eight (8) months before the Convention and are due back to the District Secretary six (6) months before the convention begins. Each voting congregation of the District is entitled to nominate two Ministers of Religion - Ordained from the roster of the Synod as candidates for the office of District President and 1st Vice President. (District Bylaws VI.C)

Circuit Visitors will be elected by the circuit forum and ratified by the District Convention (Synod Handbook pages 192 - 193 - 5.2.2). Nominations may be submitted by a voting congregation of the circuit and suggested by the district president, in consultation with the presidium of the district.

The results of the circuit forum must be mailed or scanned and e-mailed to the District Secretary no later than February 24, 2022. Circuit Forums need to be scheduled accordingly. (This will not apply to those Circuits who have responded in anticipation of a 2021 Convention.)

DUE DATES:

Nominating Ballots for District President and 1st **Vice President** are due back to the District Secretary by November 5, 2021.

Certificate of Election for Circuit Visitors must be mailed or scanned and e-mailed to the District Secretary no later than <u>January 10, 2022</u>.

CONVENTION MANUAL

The Board of Directors, District Committees, and others wishing to bring their work to the attention of the Convention, as well as congregational overtures and unofficial reports are to be submitted to the District President no later than February 24, 2022. All of this information is to be published by the District Secretary and submitted to the congregations no later than one (1) month prior to the opening of the Convention. The Convention Manual will be posted on the website, www.cnh-lcms.org. Delegates should download and print the manual for reference at the convention.
